

























**Examples of Trees & Shrubs  
that will comply with Article X  
Large Canopy Trees**

Minimum 30 feet height upon maturity, branching starts above 6' upon maturity  
Use: street, site, or parking lot tree, buffer

Upon installation, trees must be single-stem, and 2" or 3" in caliper depending on replacement tree, site tree or street tree classification. Shrubs must be 36 inches (7-9 gallon) in height at the time of installation.
