REQUIRED AIRCRAFT DEICING/ANTI-ICING BMPs

1. Contact Airport Operations **each day** that you conduct deicing/anti-icing, at (214) 670-6156.
2. At the end of each day of deicing, FAX or EMAIL this form to the DOA Environmental Division. When stating type of fluid used please indicate dilution proportion. (i.e 50-50, 45-55, etc)
3. **DEICING FLUID IS PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING STORM DRAINS DURING DRY WEATHER EVENTS.** Cover all storm drains within 50 feet of the airplane or area where the deicing/anti-icing process will occur. If deicing chemical appears to have the potential to run-off into storm drains at a distance greater than a 50 ft radius, those drains must also be protected.
4. Collect and remove the deicing/anti-icing residual remaining on the ground to the full extent in which pooling no longer exists. This should take place as soon as possible after the completion of each deicing procedure.
5. Properly dispose of the collected material.
6. Keep daily forms in your SWPPP addendum along with the MSDS. ***This requirement applies for all deicing chemicals, in addition to glycols. Separate forms must be completed if more than one type of chemical is used. All MSDS forms must be provided to the DOA.***
