Trinity Industries maintains hangar space at Dallas Love Field for use by its corporate aircraft. Light maintenance and aircraft washing is performed inside the hangar. Small amounts of hazardous wastes that may be generated through maintenance are contained indoors, on spill pallets, and are electrically grounded. This material is removed and disposed of by an approved contractor. Aircraft are fueled by a fixed-base operator, and no deicing activities occur.
