SUBJECT **USACE Stimulus Funding**

The United States Army Corps of Engineers has released the listing of Civil Works projects to be funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The Corps received \$4.6 billion to be disbursed across the United States for investigations, design, construction and maintenance projects.

The Fort Worth District received \$1.125 million to complete the Dallas Floodway Environmental Impact Statement. This is one of 67 projects to receive this type of funding across the country, and is the only study project for which the Fort Worth District received funding. The Corps is in the final stages of awarding this contract with work beginning in June.
