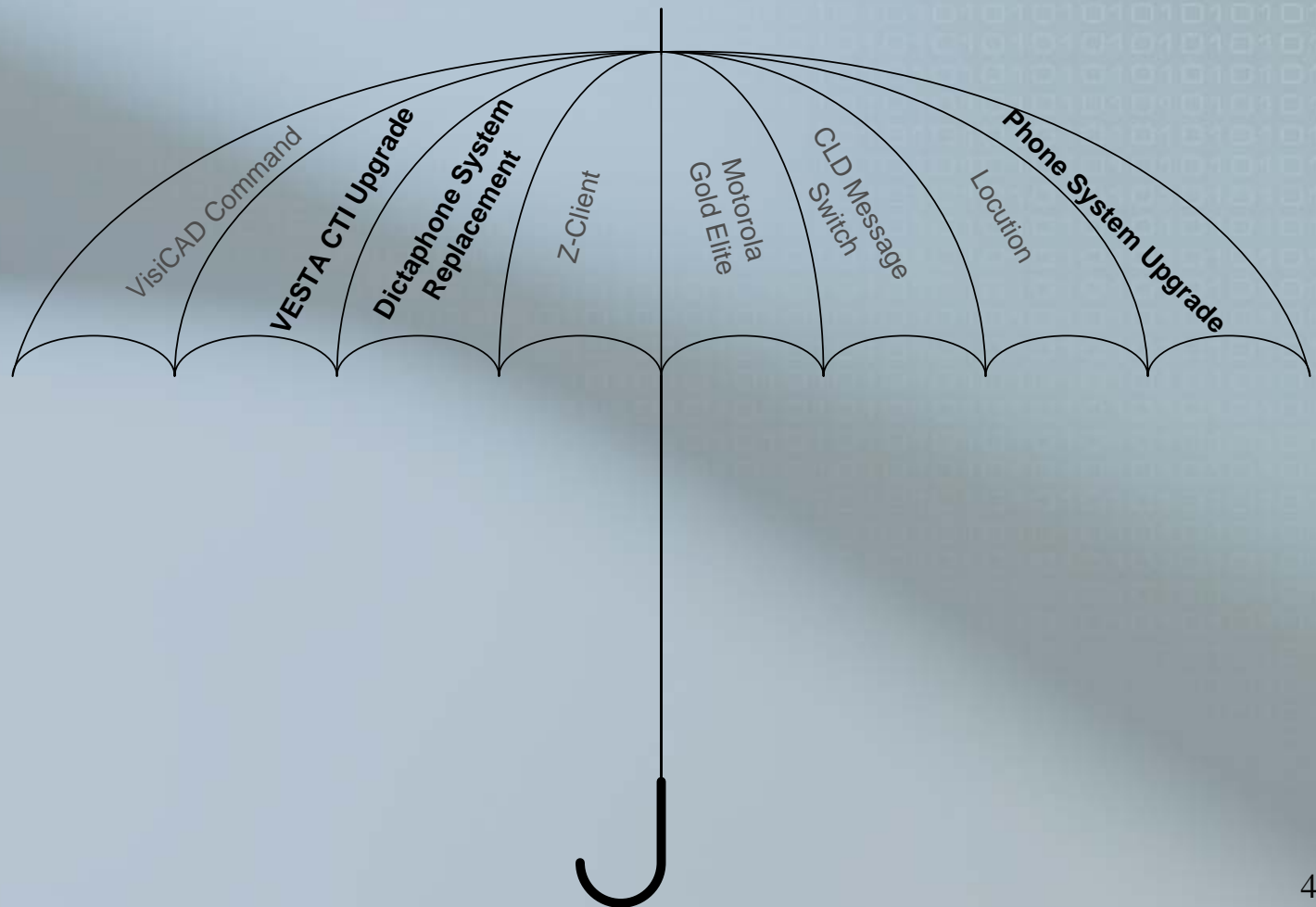


Purpose

Business Background

- 2.2 million 9-1-1 calls annually
- 1.4 million 3-1-1 & WCS calls annually
- Calls automatically routed to appropriate call center groups
- Phone number automatically presented to call agent
- Location automatically presented to call agent & displayed on map

Business Background

- City Call Centers are connected to the systems that support them including CAD and CRMS and CIABS
- Voice Recording System for 911
- Call Center Management

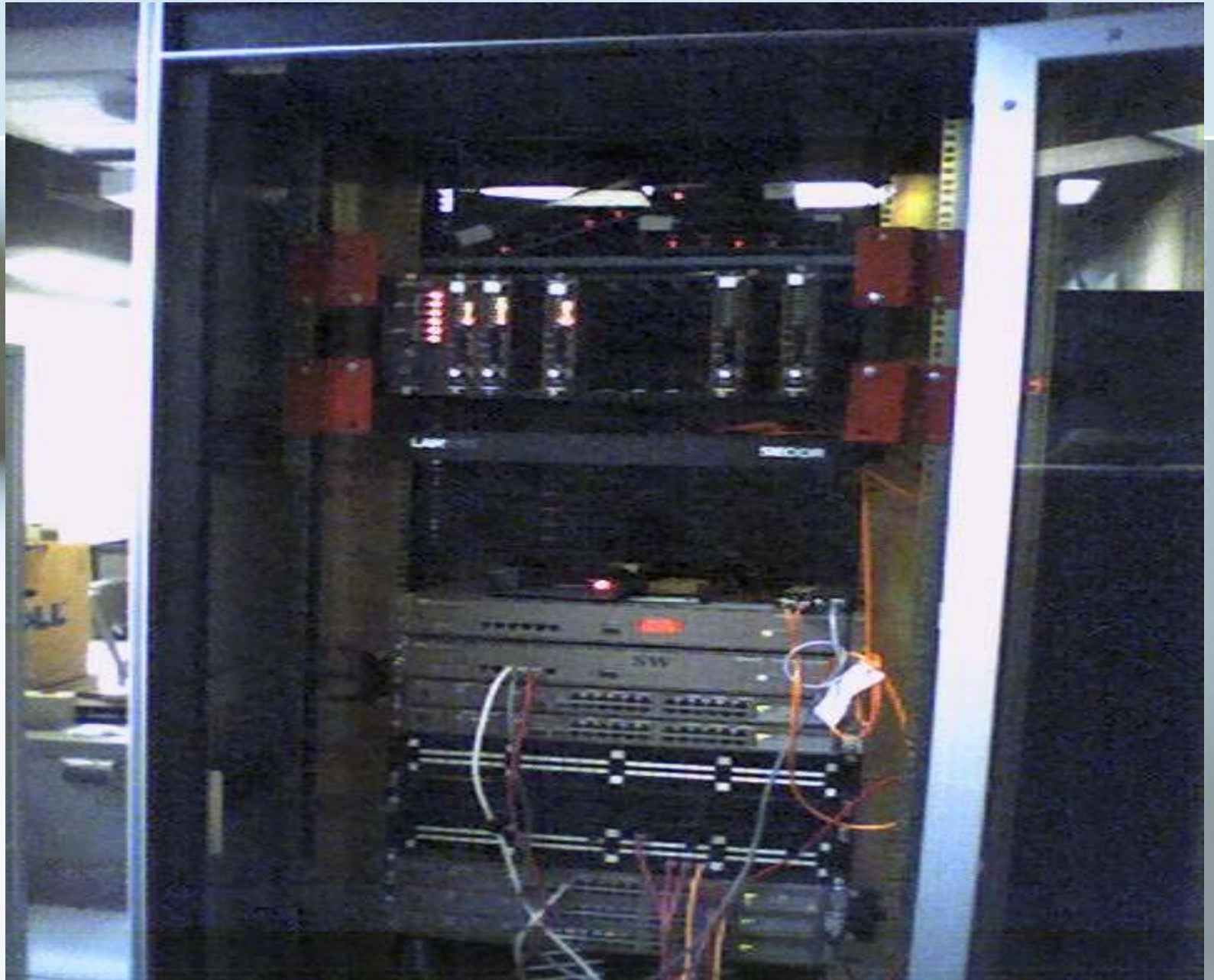

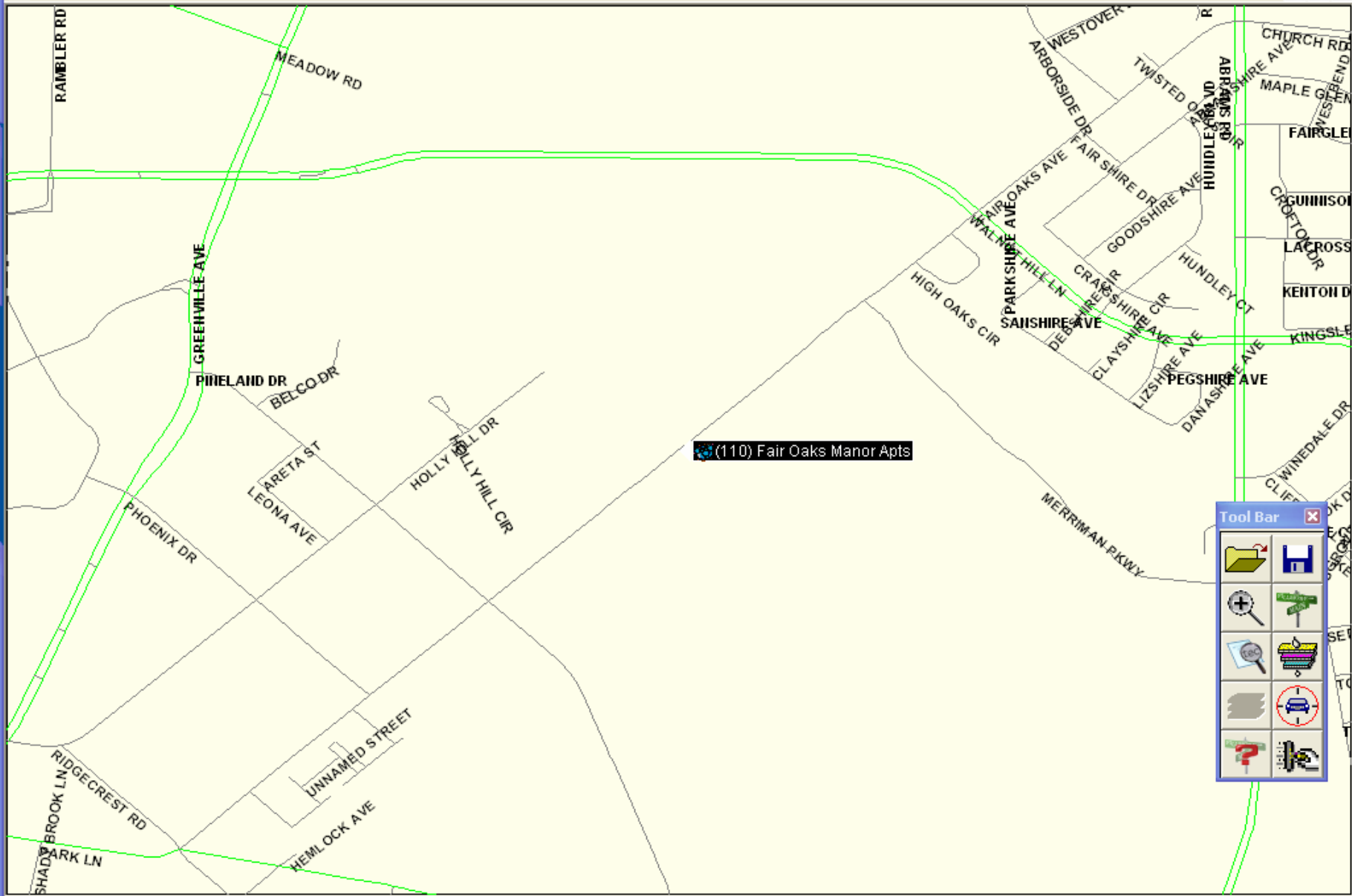

Procurement Process

- RFCSP issued December 1, 2005
 - Solicitation included a pre-proposal conference with vendors
 - Issued 3 addendums to initial RFCSP to fully answer vendor questions
- Evaluation Criteria

Proposed Solution Tech Support Capabilities, Resources, and Experience in 911 Solutions/Responsiveness	30%
Training/Ease of Conversion for Users, Support Staff	25%
Total Cost of Ownership	20%
Elegance of solution (ease of use, ease of support, ease of integration, compatibility with current systems)	15%
Compliance with published standards/specifications	10%

Procurement Process

- Three proposals received January 27, 2006
 - One proposer, Commercial Electronics, deemed non-responsive due to lack of complete solution
- Remaining vendors AT&T and Positron held demonstrations last week of February
- Evaluation committee visited municipalities using the systems April 11th and 14th
 - AT&T – City of Carrollton
 - Positron – City of Irving

Procurement Process

- Key items Evaluation Committee assessed:
 - Functionality, Reliability, Supportability
 - Integration of all tool sets
 - Integration to new CAD system
 - Full Participation of DPD, DFD and CIS

Funding for CAD Program

- Grant Funding - \$6.5 million – TriTech VisiCAD Command
- General Funds
 - FY 2005 – 2006 – Approved
 - \$547,170 - Locution – Station Alerting
 - *FY 2005 – 2006 – Budgeted Capital Notes*
 - *\$2,200,000 – PBX & VESTA Upgrade*
 - *\$800,000 – Voice Recording System Replacement*
 - \$300,000 – Radio System Upgrades

Council Action	June 28, 2006
Contract Execution	July 7, 2006
Begin Implementation	July 12, 2006
CTI Go Live	November 2006
Voice Recording Go-Live	November 2006
Call Center Management Go-Live	December 2006
