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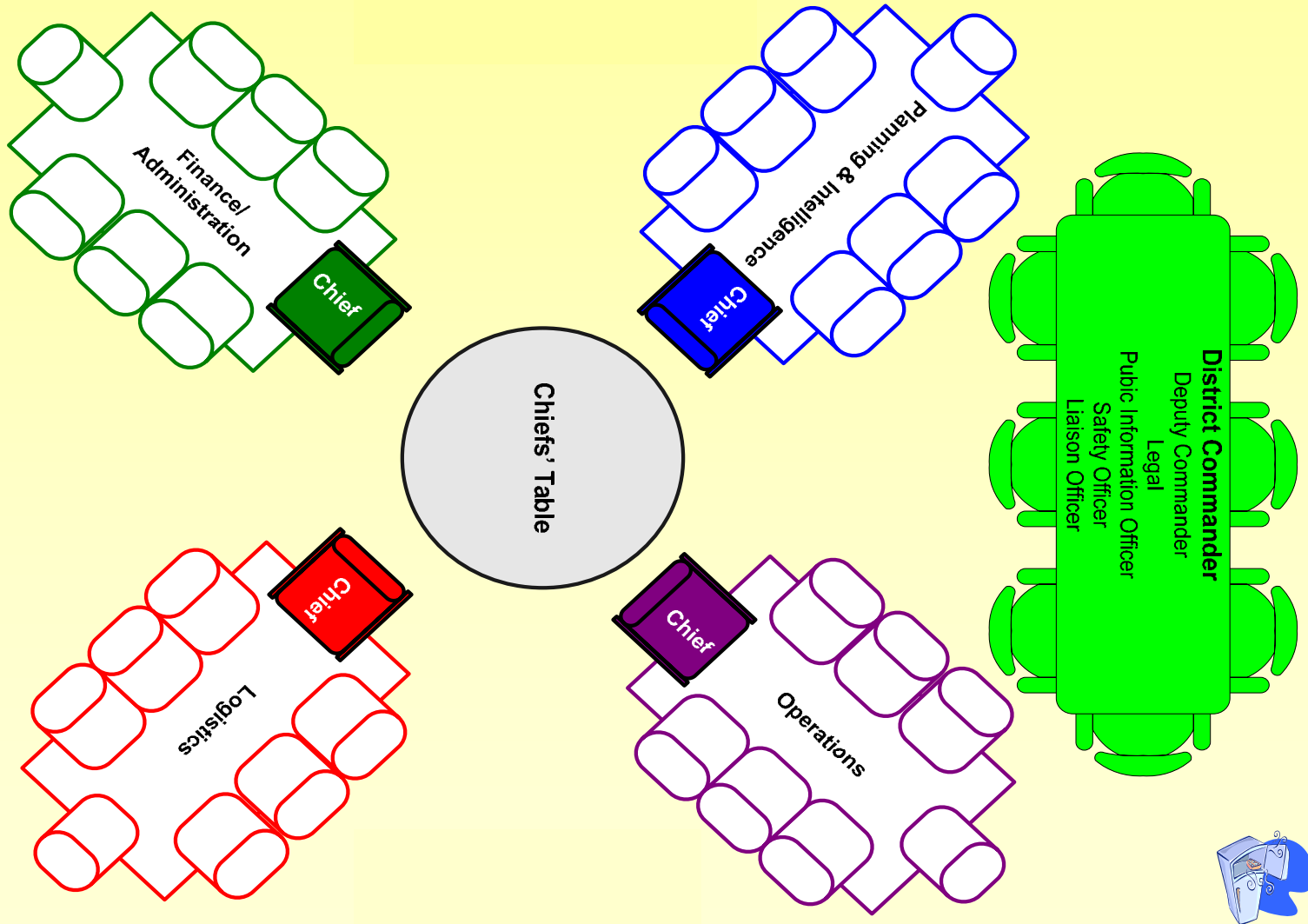

1. Update Emergency Operations Plan and Annexes
2. Conduct safety and security needs assessment
3. Update procedures and contact information with external partners
4. Develop plans for power-dependent students
5. Establish procedures for expediting emergency purchases
6. Train staff on NIMS/Incident Command System
7. Hold central & campus tabletop exercises
8. Pre-position emergency supplies and equipment
9. Develop an ICS manual & quicksteps
10. Create training modules for tabletop exercises
11. Develop and implement a train-the-trainer model
12. Ensure alternate communication systems are in place
13. Develop public awareness to help emergency preparedness.
14. Assess the level of implementation of the START on Time! FOUNDATIONS Program
15. Develop rapid response and recovery teams
16. Develop a comprehensive safety and security planning system
17. Develop a safety and security learning community
18. Institutionalize recommendations from exercises and drills
19. Pursue grant monies for accelerating emergency readiness
