BACKGROUND

This item is on the addendum as a new contract must be in place before the current contract expires on October 31, 2014.

This action does not encumber funds; the purpose of a service contract is to establish firm pricing for services, for a specific term, which are ordered on an as needed basis.

This service contract will provide shuttle services to transport City and airline employees, contractors and concessionaires to and from the Love Field Terminal area to the Love Hub Garage seven days a week, 24 hours per day. This contract allows the flexibility to meet the demands of employee transportation and requires the contractor to pick up in 20 minute intervals or less. It is anticipated the shuttle contractor will transport 3,000 employees per day. The contractor will utilize two 24 passenger and two 32 passenger buses during the initial implementation of this contract. The distance between Love Hub Garage and the Love Field Terminal is approximately 2.7 miles.

In anticipation of the Wright Amendment repeal, the parking demand at Love Field has increased creating a greater demand for parking in the terminal area. To counter this effect, City and contract employees have been relocated from Parking Garages A and B to the newly designated employee parking garage located outside the terminal area.

BACKGROUND (Continued)

As part of the solicitation process and in an effort to increase competition, Business Development and Procurement Services (BDPS) used its procurement system to send out 160 email bid notifications to vendors registered under respective commodities. To further increase competition, BDPS uses historical solicitation information, the internet, and vendor contact information obtained from user departments to contact additional vendors by phone. Additionally, in an effort to secure more bids, notifications were sent by the BDPS' ResourceLINK Team (RLT) to 25 chambers of commerce, the DFW Minority Business Council and the Women's Business Council – Southwest, to ensure maximum vendor outreach.

BACKGROUND

In July 2014, City Wide Community Development Corporation was approved for 9% Low Income Housing Tax Credits for Serenity Place Apartments, L.P. by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for the 2014 Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program. The project includes 45 multifamily units for permanent supportive housing, consisting of 40 two-bedroom units and 5 three-bedroom units.

This item was placed on the addendum because the private financing for City Wide Community Development Corporation is scheduled to close on October 15, 2014. Our changes should be in place prior to the loan closing.

Due to the complexity of the financing for the project, the City Attorney has requested additional loan terms be detailed in the agenda item.

On February 10, 2010, the City Council approved a modification to the policy for the acceptance of applications seeking City of Dallas support for low income housing tax credit financing, when the State of Texas does not require direct City of Dallas approval by Resolution No.10-0498.

On February 18, 2014, the Serenity Place Apartments' Low Income Housing Tax Credit multifamily project was briefed to the Housing Committee.



WHEREAS, City Wide Community Development Corporation, on behalf of City Wide Serenity Place Apartments, L.P. was approved by the Texas Department of Housing & Community Affairs (TDHCA) for 2014 9% Housing Tax Credits for Serenity Place Apartments, a development for affordable rental housing at 3124 South Denley in the City of Dallas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11.9(d)(7) Community Revitalization Plan, the Lancaster Corridor/Cigarette Hill Community Revitalization Plan (CRP) was adopted by the City Council on December 12, 2012 with a total budget or projected economic value of \$6,000,000 or greater and Serenity Place Apartments is located within this CRP area; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Tax Credit multifamily project to be located at 3124 South Denley Drive is selected as contributing most significantly to the concerted revitalization efforts of the city, pursuant to §11.9(d)(7)(A)(ii)(III) of the 2014 Housing Tax Credit Qualified Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2014, the City Council approved (1) support for the TDHCA 9% LIHTC application for Serenity Place Apartments; (2) a loan in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the construction costs; (3) a grant in the amount of \$959,913 for construction costs; and (4) a predevelopment grant in the amount of \$38,000 for costs associated with the tax credit by Resolution No. 14-0462 the Applicant has submitted a request for gap funding of \$1,997,913 from the City of Dallas which has been reviewed by Resolution No. 14-0462; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to provide terms to the contract; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager or his designee, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute a loan agreement in the amount of \$1,000,000 to City Wide Community Development Corporation (CWCDC), or Applicant for the development costs, including soft and hard construction costs, at 3124 South Denley Drive with the following terms:

SECTION 2. The loan agreement is contingent upon,

- a. CWCDC, or its wholly owned subsidiary, being awarded 2014 9% tax credits
- b. CWCDC must adhere to all applicable CDBG Program requirements
- c. CWCDC must execute a note, deed of trust, and deed restriction to the City for a 35-year affordability period.

SECTION 2. (continued)

- d. The outstanding principal balance of the City's \$1,000,000 loan shall bear an interest rate of 1% with interest only annual payment from available cash flow over a period of 35 years. Upon completion of the 35-year term, the \$1,000,000 loan will be repaid to the City or at the time of sale or refinancing, whichever occurs first.
- e. The loan may be subordinated to lenders.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager or his designee, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute a grant in the amount of \$959,913 to City Wide Community Development Corporation (CWCDC), or Applicant, to mitigate basis and tax issues only, for construction costs for the development at 3124 South Denley Drive. The following terms apply:

- a. CWCDC, or its wholly owned subsidiary, must be awarded 2014 9% tax credits
- b. CWCDC must adhere to all applicable CDBG Program requirements.
- c. CWCDC must complete construction and receive a certificate of occupancy.
- d. Fifty one percent of the units must be occupied by low-income households at or below 80% AMFI.
- Rents will be set at Fair Market Rents or other acceptable levels defined by TDHCA.
- f. CWCDC must execute a note, deed of trust, and deed restriction to the City for performance only. Once 51% of the units are occupied, the loan will be forgiven.
- g. The loan may be subordinated to construction and permanent lenders.

SECTION 4. That the City Manager or his designee, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute a predevelopment grant in the amount of \$38,000 to City Wide Community Development Corporation (CWCDC), or Applicant, for costs associated with the TDHCA 9% application, not conditioned upon 2014 9% LIHTC award.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney, is authorized to execute a subordination of lien to a lender who is providing construction financing on the property.

SECTION 6. That the City of Dallas' funding and endorsement of the TDHCA LIHTC application for the project, Serenity Place Apartments, will be contingent on the following: (1) the Project Owner expending a minimum of \$40,000 (a minimum of \$40,000 or \$200 per unit per year, whichever is greater) for social services for, and at no cost, to the residents of the development, based on a survey of resident's needs, to be implemented within three months of project completion; (2) inclusion of this requirement in the City's Deed Restrictions containing the social services requirement (up to 50% of the social service requirement can be fulfilled with in kind social services provided the Housing/Community Services Department gives prior approval of the social service plan).

SECTION 7. That before receiving a conditional City of Dallas building permit required by TDHCA prior to closing on the tax credits, the Project Developer will consult with the City of Dallas Sustainable Development and Construction Department with regard to security related design standards.

SECTION 8. That the City of Dallas' funding and endorsement for this project will be contingent on the Project Owner paying to the City an annual monitoring review fee in the amount of \$500, beginning on the anniversary of the closing on the 9% tax credits and ending at the end of the tax credit compliance.

SECTION 9. That the City Manager, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney, is authorized to execute releases of liens and terminate deed restrictions on the property upon compliance with the loan terms and deed restrictions.

This item is on the addendum because construction of the Able Pump Station (awarded August 27, 2014, by Resolution No. 14-1301) cannot begin until the City complies with all provisions in the Section 408 issued by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) on September 18, 2014. It is necessary to move this item forward in order to purchase the mitigation credits prior to the City issuing a Notice to Proceed for construction of the Able Pump Station.

The Able Pump Station construction project was approved by City Council on August 27, 2014. The USACE issued the Section 408 Permit for construction of the Able Pump Station, which requires the City to purchase 3.0 open water mitigation credits from an USACE approved mitigation bank prior to starting construction. The City identified three available approved mitigation banks and selected the South Forks Trinity River Mitigation Group 1, LP, the lowest cost option.

This action authorizes the purchase of mitigation credits to satisfy the requirements of the USACE's Section 408 Permit for Able Pump Station construction. The credits will be purchased prior to start of construction, which is scheduled to begin in October, 2014 and be completed by September, 2017.

Chapter III, Section 4(e) of the Dallas City Charter provides in part, "If any city council member, including the mayor, misses more than 10 percent of the total number of regular meetings held by the city council during any compensation year, then the city council member's compensation...for that year will be reduced proportionately by the percentage of meetings missed.... Meetings missed by a city council member while he or she is on the official business of the city council and at the direction of the city council will not be counted towards the percentage of missed meetings for which compensation reduction is required... but will be counted as though the member had attended the meetings that are missed while so engaged in city business."

Section 4.11(b) of the City Council Rules of Procedure provides that an absence by a council member for (1) attending a meeting or conference of a professional organization of or association of municipalities or municipal officers, (2) testifying at a legislative hearing at the request of the mayor, the city council, the chair of the council's legislative affairs committee or the city manager, or (3) attending a meeting of a board, commission, or committee to which the council member has been appointed by the mayor or the city council, will automatically be deemed to be for "official city business at the direction of the city council" and will not be counted against a city council member for purposes of determining the council member's annual compensation.

BACKGROUND

This item is on the addendum to allow staff sufficient time to compile and analyze election day polling locations submitted from Dallas County and to ensure the most current information is presented for approval.

On June 25, 2014, Ordinance No. 29376 was adopted ordering a special election on November 4, 2014. The election order adopted election day and early voting polling locations. After being advised by Dallas, Collin and Denton Counties of additional changes to these locations, Ordinance No. 29490 was adopted on September 24, 2014 which amended certain early voting and election day polling locations.

On September 29, 2014, Dallas County Elections Department notified the city additional changes were made to election day polling locations. This item will provide for approval of those changes. These changes will be incorporated in the Notice of Election that is to be posted and advertised in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Texas Election Code.

While amendments are only to Exhibit A (Election Day Polling Locations), the exhibits are presented in their entirety to allow for all locations to be within one action item. This provides ease of access from year to year.

Up to the minute changes to polling locations are common and beyond the control of the city and county as the availability of locations change even after approval from an entity has been obtained.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)

On June 25, 2014, the City Council approved Ordinance No. 29376, which ordered a special election to be held on November 4, 2014.

On September 24, 2014, the City Council approved Ordinance No. 29490, which amended certain early voting and election day polling locations for Dallas, Collin and Denton Counties.

BACKGROUND

This item was placed on the addendum because the procurement evaluation process was ongoing and not ready for vendor contract recommendations for Council consideration.

Since 1993, the City has been using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in addition to other funding sources to fund the technical assistance and other support services of the Business Assistance Centers (BACs) in the City to promote community and economic development.

BACKGROUND (Continued)

The City has recognized the importance of its role in supporting entrepreneurial and microenterprise business development to benefit CDBG eligible persons of the City by supporting the BAC program. BACs located within the City will provide technical assistance, incubator space and other support services to low to moderate income individuals that presently own or wish to start a microenterprise. Per HUD regulations "microenterprise" means a business having five or fewer employees, one or more of whom own the business.

Technical assistance related micro-enterprise development services may include, but not be limited to: business counseling, seminars/training, incubator space, business plan and loan packaging assistance, financial and business management, and other eligible services which foster economic development opportunities for low-to-moderate income (LMI) persons who already own or are interested in starting a microenterprise within the City.



COMPREHENSIVE PLAN: The <u>forwardDallas! Comprehensive Plan</u> was adopted by the City Council in June 2006. The <u>forwardDallas! Comprehensive Plan</u> outlines several goals and policies which can serve as a framework for assisting in evaluating the applicant's request. The Plan identifies the request site as being in an Urban Mixed Use Building Block.

The Urban Mixed-Use Building Block incorporates a vibrant mix of residential and employment uses at a lower density than the Downtown Building Block. These areas are typically near Downtown, along the Trinity River or near major transit centers. Examples include Uptown, the City Place/West Village area, Stemmons Design District, Cedars and Deep Ellum. Urban Mixed-Use Building Blocks provide residents with a vibrant blend of opportunities to live, work, shop and play within a closely defined area. Buildings range from high-rise residential or mid-rise commercial towers to townhomes and small corner shops. Good access to transit is a critical element. Similar to Downtown, the Urban Mixed-Use Building Blocks offer employment and housing options and are important economic growth areas for businesses. People on foot or bike can enjoy interesting storefronts at ground level with benches, public art, on-street parking and wide sidewalks, creating an appealing streetscape. Large parking areas and other auto-oriented land uses are typically located at the edges.

Area Plans:

The Oak Lawn Special Purpose District and the Oak Lawn Plan include the following objectives:

- (1) To achieve buildings more urban in form.
- (2) To promote and protect an attractive street level pedestrian environment with continuous street frontage activities in retail areas.
- (3) To encourage the placement of off-street parking underground or within buildings similar in appearance to non-parking buildings.
- (4) To promote development appropriate to the character of nearby neighborhood uses by imposing standards sensitive to scale and adjacency issues.

- (5) To use existing zoned development densities as a base from which to plan, while providing bonuses to encourage residential development in commercial areas.
- (6) To discourage variances or zoning changes which would erode the quantity or quality of single-family neighborhoods, or would fail to adhere to the standards for multiple-family neighborhoods and commercial areas.
 - (7) To promote landscape/streetscape quality and appearance.

The applicant's request for a LC Light Commercial Subdistrict meets objectives 5 and 7. The remaining objectives are not applicable to the request because the applicant will convert the existing single family structures into an office and restaurant use. The entire block will eventually be redeveloped as a mixed use development that may consist of office tower and retail uses.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

Land Use Compatibility: A portion of the site is developed with 2, single family dwellings. The request site is contiguous to a larger tract of undeveloped land (PDS No. 83). The property north of the site that is across Ivan Street, is also undeveloped (PDS No. 77). The main uses that are permitted in PDS No. 83 and PDS No. 77 are for Light Commercial Subdistrict uses. The applicant's request for a LC Light Commercial Subdistrict will be consistent with the main uses that are permitted in the adjacent Planned Development Subdistricts. The applicant anticipates on developing the entire block in the future with a mixed use development that may consist of office and restaurant uses. A portion of the request site has a D liquor Control Overlay that prohibits the sale of alcoholic beverages. The applicant has requested to change the D to a D-1 to allow for alcohol sales.

<u>Landscaping</u>: Landscaping must be in accordance with the landscaping requirements in Part I of Planned Development District No. 193.

<u>Parking</u>: The applicant will file a remote parking agreement to permit the required parking for the proposed use. The applicant owns the property that is adjacent to the site.


PROPOSED SITE PLAN
