On August 13, 2014, the City Council appointed Richard E. Carrizales to the DART Board for a term that expired in 2016.

On June 8, 2016, the City Council appointed Richard E. Carrizales to the DART Board (Position 01) for a term that expires on June 30, 2018.

FISCAL INFORMATION

No cost consideration to the City.

WHEREAS, the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) Board was created by the state legislature under Transportation Code Chapter 452; and

WHEREAS, Dallas is a participating member and the City Council has appointed eight members and one "shared" member to the DART Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Texas Transportation Code Section 452.542(a), a member of the sub-regional board serves at the pleasure of the appointing governing body; and

WHEREAS, the City Council appointed Richard E. Carrizales to the DART Board (Position 01) on June 8, 2016, for a term that expires on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, because the Dallas City Council appointed Richard E. Carrizales (Position 01) to serve at the pleasure of the City of Dallas, the City Council may remove him at any time.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Richard E. Carrizales is hereby removed from the DART Board of Directors.
