TxDOT contractors are repairing and replacing pavement on a 2.6-mile portion of SH 78/Garland Road in the city of Dallas. The project will require various lane closures as the roadway's top layer of asphalt is removed and major sections of worn concrete pavement are replaced.

The contractor removed asphalt pavement in the northbound direction and is currently making repairs to concrete pavement underneath. Concrete pavement repairs will be completed the week of July 13.

Asphalt overlay: July 17-24 **Pavement markings:** July 24-27



SH 78/Garland Road is projected to be complete by Aug. 31, 2015, weather permitting.
