



Official Dress Code Policy*

ACCEPTABLE CASUAL WEAR (appropriately fitted):

- **Khakis or casual slacks**
- **Denim skirts /Jeans/ Capri's (no holes, frayed/torn, tie-dyed/cut-up, etc)**
- **Shorts (acceptable length is between mid-thigh and the knee– no exceptions)**
- **Blouses (if covering tube top, must be buttoned)**
- **Hair styles must be neat, clean and well groomed (no head coverings)**
- **Athletic/sturdy shoes (note: concrete flooring in each facility)**
- **Skirts and dresses must be mid-thigh or longer**
- **Socks (optional)**

UNACCEPTABLE CASUAL WEAR (Volunteers in violation of official dress code will not be allowed to volunteer)

- **Revealing attire**
- **Baseball caps**
- **Poorly coordinated outfits**
- **Humorous attire or accessories**
- **Rugged outdoor wear**
- **Active wear (jogging suits, wind suits)**
- **Sleeveless attire**
- **Frill overload - no bling/bling**
- **Stretch legging**
- **Bunches of bangles**
- **No sandals / scruffy shoes/flip-flops/high-heeled, wheeled or cleared shoes**
- **Spandex**
- **Visible tattoos or body piercings are not permitted**
- **Sleepwear**
- **Clothing exposing midriff**
- **Biker shorts**
