The meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m.

The Board entered into executive session from 6:34 to 6:36 p.m. to receive legal advice from the City Attorney on the proposed rule changes to Civil Service Rule XXIII REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAINEE POLICE OFFICER. There was no action taken in the Executive Session.

Chief Simpson outlined the proposed rule changes to Civil Service Rule XXIII REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAINEE POLICE OFFICER. They are:

Civil Service RULE XXIII. *Section 1A (1)* Have at least forty-five (45) semester hours of college credit with a C average or better from an accredited college or university. **OR** A minimum of 36 months active service in the Armed Forces of the United States with an Honorable Discharge (Allowance for no more than 10 calendar days less than 36 months; more than 10 days requires approval from the Assistant Chief of Police over the Personnel and Development Division). **OR** Thirty-six (36) months of fulltime certified law enforcement experience (from date of receipt of license) with a city, county or state law enforcement agency and be currently employed or separated from the agency for no more than 4 months prior to the date of application.

The Chief said that the changes had been discussed with the employee associations and there were no objections. Ms. Moss added that it had been given the legal okay too.

The Vice-Chair opened the public hearing to receive comments. There being no one at the meeting to speak, the public hearing was closed. The Secretary added that no written comments had been received.

With no further discussion on the matter, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the proposed rule changes.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
