1. Contemplated or pending litigation or matter where legal advice is requested of the City Attorney. Section 551.071 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
2. Personnel matters involving discussions of the qualifications for performance identifiable individuals already employed or being considered for employment by the City. Section 51.074 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
3. The deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices. Section 551.076 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
4. Discussions concerning sale or lease of real property, or negotiated contracts for donations to the City, when such discussions would have a detriment on the negotiating positions of the City. Section 551.072 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
5. A contract for a prospective gift or donation to the City, if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the City in negotiations with a third person. Section 551.073 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
