THE CHILD CARE SERVICES PROGRAM SEEKS TO:

- Remove financial barriers to quality child care **By** providing a subsidy to parents who need help with child care and who **DO NOT** qualify for any other forms of public assistance.
- Remove geographic barriers to “public funded” child care **By** allowing parents to pick up any licensed program that best meet their needs.
- Assist parents in choosing quality child care **By** training parents in what to look for when choosing child care
- Assist parents in taking over the full cost of their child care by the end of the program **By** providing financial planning and budget development workshops and follow-up groups for parents in the program
- Have impact on the level of quality care being provided **By** providing workshops and technical assistance to participating child care programs in areas in need and interest.

This program pays a portion of child care expenses for working parents whose income falls below 180% of the states median income. Individuals in this income range are frequently labeled as the “working poor,” because their income places them just above the level to be eligible for other forms of public assistance such as Child Care Management Assistance (CCMA). It is this population, who, given limited assistance, can become fully self- sufficient within a short period of time.

TO QUALIFY FOR THIS PROGRAM YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

- Reside within the city limits of Dallas
- Choose child care in licensed facility within the city limits of Dallas
- Have legal custody of the children you are enrolling
- Total gross monthly income for **ALL** adults in your household must fall within the following guidelines for income and family size
