



Cottonwood Trail

140 Maham Road

General Description

This pleasant combination for hiking, roller blading, jogging and biking goes through a residential area, along a TXU easement. It is being developed in phases with extensive landscape and sitting areas. The trail winds south from the corner of Spring Valley and Maham Roads to Clear Springs. This trail has multimodal access to major shopping areas, transportation, medical facilities and educational institutions. This trail is envisioned as a “livable cities” project that will reduce traffic and air pollution. Cottonwood Trail is a joint community project between the City of Dallas Park and Recreation Department, Richardson and North Dallas Coalition Organization (RANDCO) and Texas Utilities.

Directions to Trailhead from Downtown Dallas

Take North Central Expressway (US Hwy. 75) to Spring Valley; go left on Spring Valley to Maham Road. Go left on Maham Road. The trail will be on the right.
