



Glendale Park Trail

1300 E. Ledbetter

General Description

Purchased in 1938, this trail is located in the southeast Oak Cliff area of Dallas at Glendale Park. It meanders through the park and joins the central half of the park to the southern half with a hike and bike bridge that spans Five-Mile Creek. This scenic trail provides patrons the opportunity to hike, bike and rollerblade. From the large majestic trees to the soothing sounds of the creek water as it flows through the park, it provides a rustic and relaxing experience for all. The park also, offers a community swimming pool, several parking lots, lighted tennis courts, picnic shelters and playgrounds.

Directions to Trailhead from Downtown Dallas

Go south on I-35 approximately 5 miles to Ledbetter Drive (Loop 12); turn left on Ledbetter Drive and go 1.5 miles to Frio Drive; turn right. The main parking lot is on the right.
