1300 Riverwood

General Description

This was designated as an historic natural trail for hiking the Trinity Bluffs. Settlers came to this site, which is the highest point on the Trinity River, to wait until the river lowered so they could cross into what is now called Dallas. There are an abundance of native plants and many predatory and migratory birds. Two annual Riverfest Celebrations honor the historic and native habitats of the area.

Directions to Trailhead from Downtown Dallas

Take US Hwy. 175 southeast to Loop 12, turn right, then turn left on Longbranch, which changes its name to Riverwood. Follow Riverwood until it dead-ends, turn right on the flexbase road to the trailhead.

Difficulty moderate

Best time of year to hike anytime, except summer
