

Holiday Travel Information for Love Field Airport Passengers

Tuesday, December 21, 2010 – During the final weeks of the 2010 holiday travel season, the Dallas Love Field Airport will continue to assist passengers as they navigate through the airport while improvements are made to the terminal and concourse.

The ongoing construction of the Airport, known as the Love Field Modernization Program (LFMP), is not expected to delay travel schedules; however, high-fly travel days during the holiday will continue through Monday, December 27.

For travelers not familiar with the Love Field's reconfiguration, be aware that:

- Love Field now has Terminal 1 and Terminal 2.
- Terminal 1 now serves Delta and Continental/United Airlines, accommodating Delta and Continental/United Airlines passenger activity, including ticketing, baggage check in and baggage claim. Garage B is the most convenient parking for Terminal 1.
- Terminal 2 continues to serve Southwest Airlines, including curbside check in, ticketing, baggage check in and baggage claim. Garages A and B are still convenient parking for Terminal 2.
- To travel between Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, customers should follow signs and use the Garage Pedestrian Bridge.

The Cell Phone Lot holds 45 vehicles and is located on the east side of Cedar Springs Road, north of the long-term parking shuttle and the Hertz Rental Car Facility. Follow directional signs along Cedar Springs.

If you're flying with Southwest Airlines (Terminal 2) you will notice that the interior construction lobby wall has been updated to include floor-to-ceiling signage promoting the New Love Field Airport. Four monitors have also been installed on the lobby wall and play the official LFMP video about the history of Love Field and the new Love Field Airport. Travelers are encouraged to follow these holiday travel tips:

- Arrive at least 120 minutes before your flight to allow enough time for check-in, baggage check and security. Check with your airline for flight departure/arrival status.
- Carryon items are limited to one small bag and one personal item (e.g.: camera, laptop, briefcase, purse).
- Travelers are not allowed to carry on or check in wrapped holiday gifts. All holiday gifts must be unwrapped.
- To minimize unnecessary congestion, do not park curbside to wait for arriving passengers. Use the Cell Phone parking lot or the parking garage. Garage parking is free if parked for less than 30 minutes.

- LUV Helpers, volunteers in Red Vests, can direct you to your terminal and answer questions regarding construction and relocation.
- When arriving to the airport, tune in to Love Radio 1580 AM for information on traffic and updates related to Love Field.
