

City of Dallas to launch Trial of Free Shuttle Service

What: The City of Dallas will launch the trial of a free area shuttle service along Main Street in Deep Ellum.

This trial shuttle service will pick up passengers in the City-owned parking lot underneath Central Expressway and make periodic stops to drop off and receive passengers on Main Street between Good Latimer and Walton Street. Initial service will run for six months on Fridays and Saturdays from 6:30 p.m. to 2:30 a.m.
