



**NOTICE OF REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD FOR THE
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CONSOLIDATED PLAN ON
PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CITY'S
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT POLICY FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS
EXTENDED THROUGH OCTOBER 26, 2010**

On June 2002, the Dallas City Council adopted a policy to discontinue the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDGB) funds for public improvement projects at nonprofit organizations.

On June 9, 2010, the City Council authorized a public hearing to be held on August 11, 2010 to receive citizen's comments on proposed changes to the City's current policy. The proposed changes will rescind the current policy to discontinue the use of CDBG funds for public improvement activities at nonprofit organizations; and adopt a new policy for which CDBG funds will be used to fund public improvement activities at nonprofit organizations.

On August 11, 2010, the City Council extended the review and comment period through September 22, 2010.

On September 22, 2010, the City Council extended the review and comment period through October 26, 2010. Close of the public hearing is scheduled for October 26, 2010 in the Dallas City Council Chambers, 1500 Marilla Street, Dallas, Texas. Final approval of the substantial amendment is scheduled to follow the close of the public hearing. Citizens may submit written comments on or before 10:00 a.m., October 26, 2010 to:
