## Public Information and Discussion Meeting set for South Dallas/Fair Park Trust Fund Grant Applications

Community Organizations that qualify for funding from the South Dallas/Fair Park Trust Fund are invited to submit proposals for funding between March 3, 2009 and April 3, 2009 at 4 p.m. There are three categories of grants for which applicants can place proposals.

- 1) Community-Based Non-Profit Grant:** This grant is for agencies that have been designated as 501(c)(3) by the IRS. Maximum grant amount is \$35,000. Maximum period is for 3 years funding.
- 2) Challenge Grant:** Any community based organization, whether non-profit or not, may apply for this grant. Maximum grant amount is \$5,000.
- 3) Public Safety Grant:** Any community based organization whether non profit or not, may apply for this grant. Maximum amount is \$10,000. Public Safety Projects must directly relate to an aspect of crime prevention or abatement.

**Public Meetings:** To discuss particular aspects of eligibility and application for annual grants are open to the public with accessible parking. The meetings will be held as follows: Tuesday, March 10; Thursday, March 12; Tuesday, March 17; Thursday, March 19; Tuesday, March 24; Thursday, March 26, 2009.
