Hecho en Dallas / Made in Dallas Exhibit is an annual juried exhibition that showcases recent work by professional artists who reside and are active in the artistic environment of Dallas area. The exhibition was conceived by the Latino Cultural Center in recognition of the talented pool of artists whose creative endeavors give vitality to the cultural movement in Greater Dallas. For the 2008 edition of this annual exhibition, the guest jurors reviewed 89 applications and selected the twelve artists for the exhibition. Serving as jurors were Phillip Collins, Enrique Fernandez, and artists Ivonne Acero and Benito Huerta.
