Storm debris to be collected on normal schedule

Dallas residents can take debris to transfer stations or landfill

The City of Dallas has cleared roads and thoroughfares of debris from the thunderstorms and winds that affected the city earlier this week. While the storm was not of a magnitude seen in previous years, Streets crews were dispatched to respond to hundreds of calls of downed trees in rights-of-way. Major thoroughfares were cleared first, with secondary and residential streets following.

Residents who have limbs, brush or other vegetative debris may place their cut and stacked tree limbs at the curb for collection during the regular brush / bulk collection schedule. You may obtain your brush week schedule by logging in to the city website at www.dallascityhall.com or calling 311. Citations for “out of cycle” brush waste will not be issued for **vegetative waste set-outs only**. Residents may request a “Cost-Plus” service to remove the materials prior to their next scheduled brush week, for a fee.

James Childers, assistant director of the city’s code compliance department, confirms his staff will not issue citations for storm debris of a vegetative nature (tree limbs, trunks, shrubs) through July 18. “We want folks to have an option for the waste collection, but this isn’t a free pass for people to put bulk trash out when they shouldn’t. We’ll be checking to make sure the items placed out for collection are storm-related,” Childers states.

Dallas residents may also take storm debris to City transfer stations and the landfill during regular operating hours, and will be asked to show proof of residency with a driver’s license or current water bill. Please call 311 for any additional information.
