

# Uploading Multiple Page Documents in DallasNow

When submitting plans in *DallasNow*, many disciplines;(e.g. architectural, structural, civil, etc.), require multiple sheets to be included as part of a single plan set.

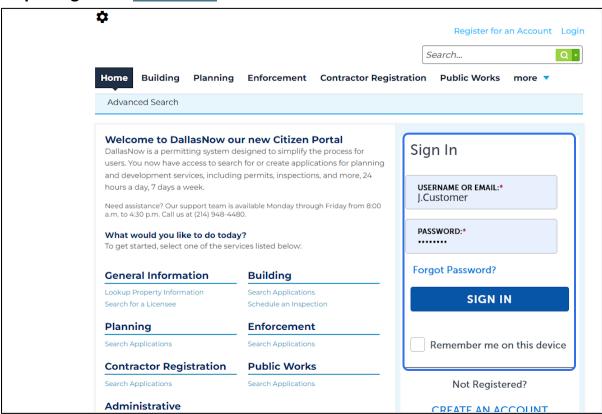
Instead of uploading each sheet one at a time, customers should combine all related pages into a single PDF file per discipline (for example, all architectural sheets together, all electrical sheets together).

This ensures that reviewers can easily navigate the plans in sequence, reduces upload time, and helps prevent missing documents. When saving the files into a pdf, be sure to use the Planning and Development Drawing Sheet Filename Format.

The steps below explain how to prepare, name, and upload multi-page documents correctly.

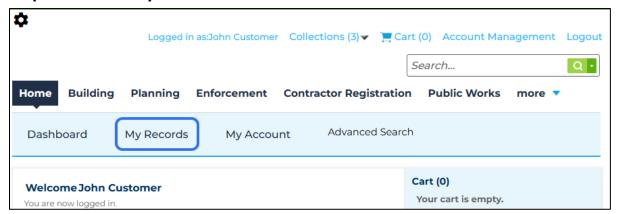
#### **Locating the Record to Attach Files**

Step 1. Sign In to **DallasNow**.

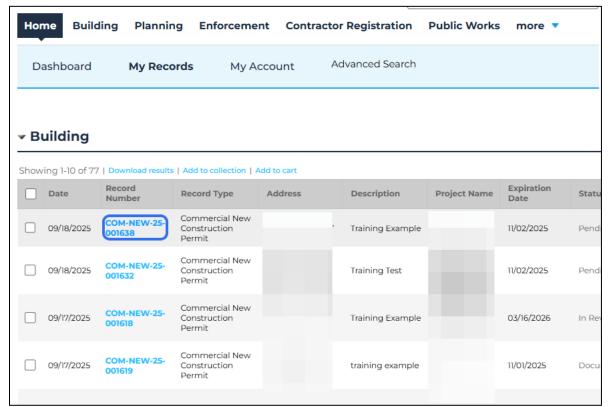




#### Step 2. Click on My Records.

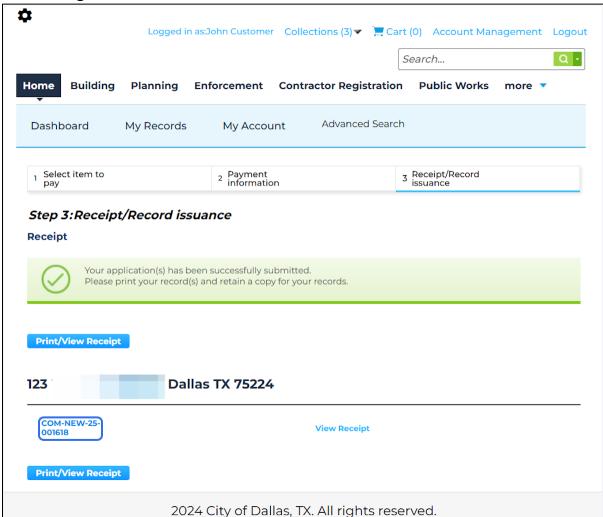


#### Step 3. Click on desired record number.





**Note:** If you have just completed an application and need to upload additional documents, you can also click on the record number displayed. to access the Record Page.

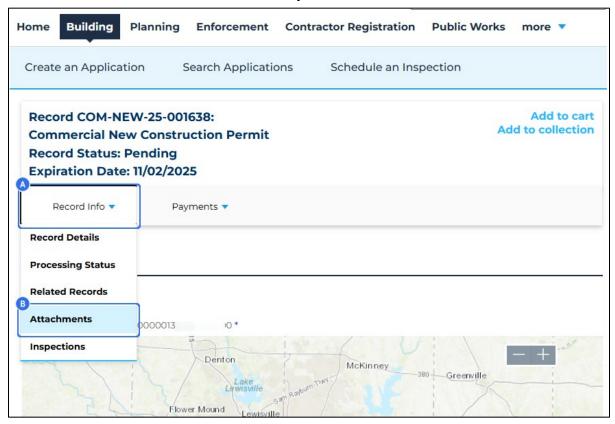




### **Uploading Multiple Page Documents**

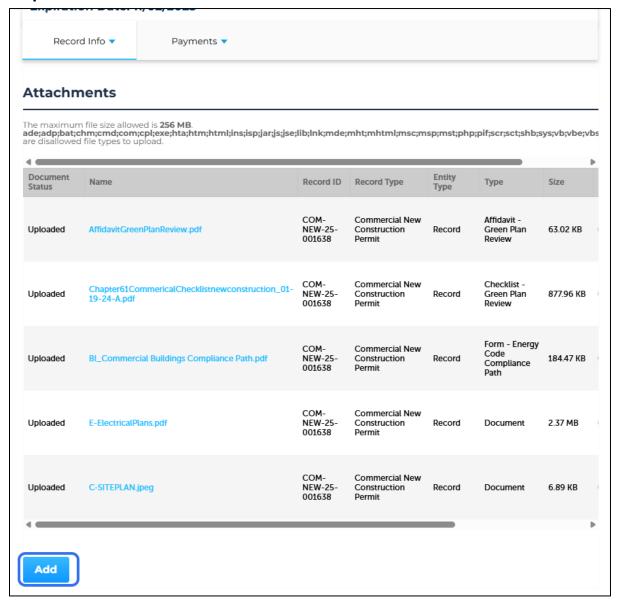
#### Step 4.

- A. Click on Record Info
- B. Click on Attachments from the drop down menu.





#### Step 5. Click on Add.

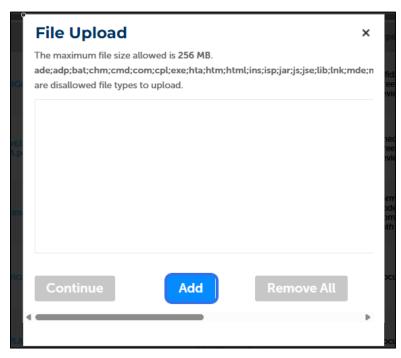




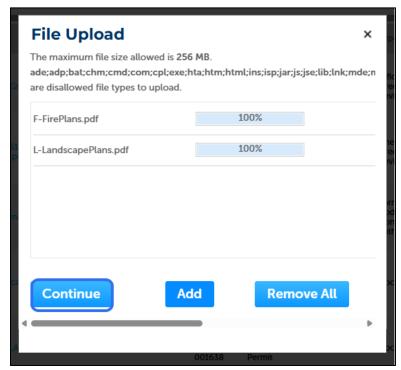
#### Step 6. Click on Add, and upload documents.

#### Note:

- You can upload multiple documents by clicking Add again.
- The file size limit is 256MB.



Step 7. Click on Continue once all desired documents have been uploaded.



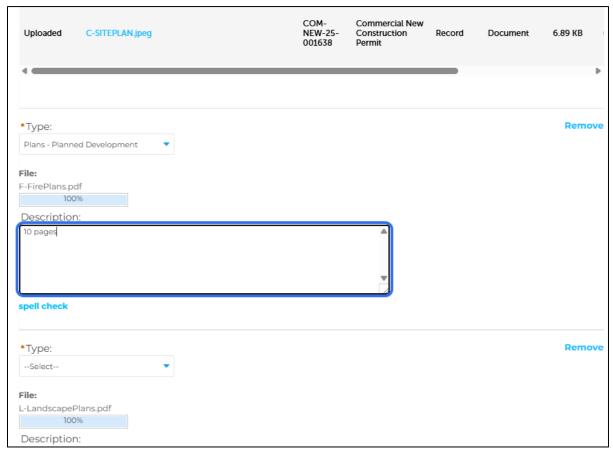


## Step 8. Click on the Type drop down menu and select the appropriate selection.

Note: Use Plans – Plan Development for document types not listed.

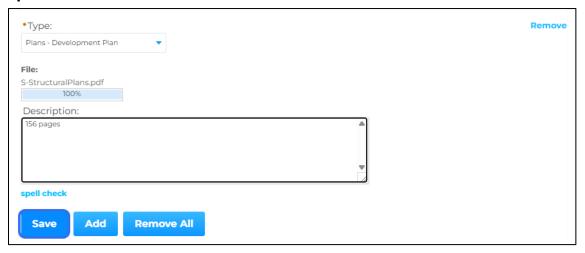


#### Step 9. Type in a Description. (OPTIONAL)
