Request

DCA190-003

- Consideration of amending Section 51A-4.209(b)(5), “Multifamily Use,” of Chapter 51A of the Dallas City Code to allow a parking reduction to provide adequate area for the placement of recycling containers.



Background

- On June 13, 2018, City Council passed Section 18-5.1, “Collection and Removal of Recyclable Materials from Multifamily Sites.”
- Starting January 1, 2020, all multifamily properties will be required to provide recycling services



Issue

- Section 18-5.1(e) of the Multifamily Recycling Ordinance contains a provision for a parking reduction in order to provide adequate space for recycling containers
- Section 51A-4.209(b)(5), “Multifamily Use,” does not allow for a parking reduction



Proposal

- Amend Section 51A-4.209(b)(5), “Multifamily Use,” to allow for a parking reduction of one required parking space to provide adequate area for the placement of recycling containers
