The City Plan Commission Thoroughfare Committee was briefed by staff on each item on the agenda and a question-and-answer period followed each briefing.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The February 5, 2026 City Plan Commission Thoroughfare Committee meeting minutes were presented. Jack Kocks moved to adopt the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by John Denholm and unanimously adopted.

The following items were presented for consideration.

1. Crouch Road Thoroughfare Plan Amendment

Amendment to the City of Dallas Thoroughfare Plan to change the designation of Crouch Road between Patrol Way and Lancaster Road from a standard two-lane undivided roadway in 56 feet of right-of-way (S-2-U) to a minimum four-lane undivided roadway in 60 feet of right-of-way(M-4-U).

Motion: It was moved to deny the proposed amendment to the City of Dallas Thoroughfare Plan to change the designation of Crouch Road between Patrol Way and Lancaster Road from a standard two-lane undivided roadway in 56 feet of right-of-way (S-2-U) to a minimum four-lane undivided roadway in 60 feet of right-of-way(M-4-U).

Discussion: Chair Kingston and Commissioner Herbert expressed concerns regarding the sidewalk design, specifically the lack of a buffer between the sidewalk and roadway. Chair Kingston stated that this aspect of the proposal was inconsistent with Vision Zero goals.

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Avenue is located behind the curb. Staff confirmed that the sidewalk is located behind the curb.

ADJOURNMENT

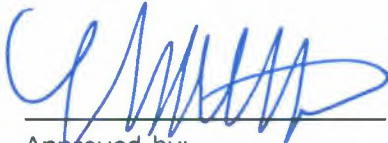
