Lake June Project Overview








The project is located in Southeast Dallas







Garver's design and construction approach minimizes impacts to the community







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Lake June Pump Station is critical to the Dallas Water Utilities system




- Concrete failure and risk
 of structural failure
- Electrical systems that are obsolete
- Critical assets that are beyond useful life.





The project scope includes two new ground storage tanks and a new pump station







Ground storage tanks will be built first, and construction is expected to start November 2025







The new pump station and ground storage tanks will fit into the community







The project is broken into two construction packages




Construction Package A: 11/2025-11/2027

Construction Package B: 3/2028-3/2031













• Request:

The SUP request number is Z245-203 (Z-25-000006). It is scheduled to be heard by the City Plan Commission on June 26, 2025.



















