4. Accelerant Detection K9 Program

Presenter: Assistant Chief Ted Padgett, Dallas Fire-Rescue Department Captain Marcus Stephenson and K9 Kenna

Accelerant – ignitable liquids that hasten the development of fire to commit arson.

K9's as Detectors:

- Used by DFR
- Detect ignitable liquids in parts per quadrillion (PPQ)
- Scent discrimination of ignitable liquids from fire products
- Pin point location
- Cost \$6 \$10,000 for trained accelerant K9
