SUBJECT **Motion Clarification to the Proposed Historic Preservation Policy During the November 15, 2022 Housing and Homelessness Solutions Committee Meeting**

On Tuesday, November 15, 2022 the Housing and Homelessness Solutions (HHS) Committee was briefed on a proposed Historic Preservation Policy. This memo serves as a follow-up clarification to the motion made and approved under Item A.

During the HHS Committee, Chair Thomas requested that the language of the motion approved under Item A, An Introduction to Historic Preservation Policy, be included in a Friday Memo. The summary of the motion is as follows:

Council Member Ridley made a motion to hold the item until staff had an opportunity to craft a plan for community engagement. The motion was seconded. Council Member Ridley clarified that his motion was to hold the item until the January HHS Committee meeting. There were no objections, and the motion passed 4-2.
